REFLECTIONS

I was going through my notebooks the other day. (I have every letter I've ever sent on Paddle Tennis' behalf as well as everything that's been sent to me) and I found an article by Murray Geller, the man who updated and modernized PT in the 1950's. I would like to quote some of that article and have done so below:

◆ *"Any tennis player will find paddle tennis extremely easy. It takes about 10 minutes to make the adjustment to the short-handled paddle. After that, the player can fit right into a fast game of doubles-- although it takes a little longer to compete on even terms with the experienced players. It's "tennis without tears". Jim Kaplan, Sports Illustrated.*
 So while the beginner will find playing this a pleasurable

game, mastering it is another matter!

Question: Why doesn't paddle tennis have a standard ball?

Answer: WHO SAID

we didn't?

In fact, the ball is more uniform in paddle tennis than tennis. Official paddle tennis rules mandate a pressurized tennis ball approved by the US Tennis Association, which has its internal pressure reduced by being punctured with a needle so that when dropped from a height of 6 feet to the court surface the bounce will rebound to no more than 31" (the height of the net).

Please note that the paddle tennis ball is tested on the surface of the very court on which the match is to be played. In other words, if the match is to be played on a hard, fast court, slow asphalt, or a clay court, the bounce will be identical. This differs from tennis when the factory tested "standard" ball will bounce differently or clay, hard court, etc.

And we won't even mention the temperature factor!

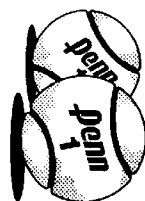
PADDLE TENNIS HALL OF FAME

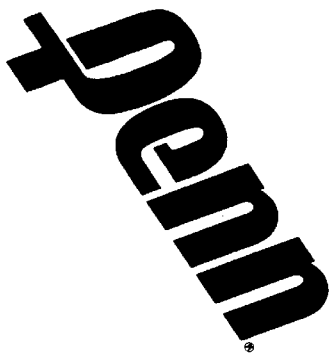
