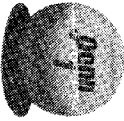

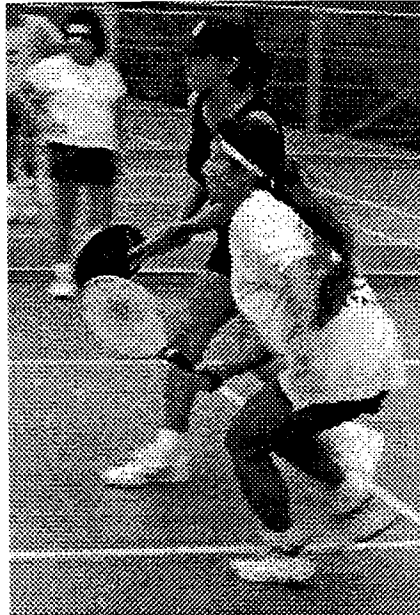

Everything You Wanted to Know About Paddle Tennis but Forgot to Ask

Primers by Sol Hauptman
(We're very proud to have Sol Hauptman giving a series of technique tips in the Paddle Tennis Times--Ed.)

This month:

FOREHAND VOLLEY

Sol Says:

1. Always *lead* with your 'front' foot. This means if you are right-handed, you will be leading with your left foot. (If lefthanded, lead with right foot.)
2. The face of your paddle should always be in front of your body.
3. Watch the ball come off of **your** paddle (*you'll only be able to do this if your paddle is in front of you!*)
4. Play the ball--don't let it play you. Attack it!
5. The paddle face of your volley will show you the direction your shot will go.
6. Remember: The volley is always a block off of your opponent's shot, **Not a major (or minor) swing!**

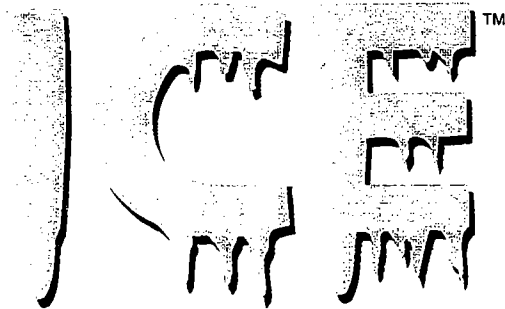

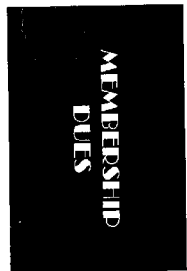
