"Moving Up"

Paddle Tennis Tournaments usually have several different divisions: Open, A, B, C.

(It's a way of "handicapping" ED). The Open Division is the expert and top category paddle tennis player (since we don't have paid professionals--ED.)

The A Division is the advanced player with the B Division serving the Intermediate player and so on. The reason for having different divisions is so that matches within each division will be competitive and engrossing. When an individual or team within a division is much better than the other players in that category, play is not competitive and the matches are usually dull and monotonous.

Also, the players who are not as developed become discouraged and often do not continue playing tournaments--as a result, the event draw suffers.

SO HOW DOES A PLAYER KNOW WHEN IT'S TIME TO "MOVE UP"?

In the not too distant past, the unwritten rule was: If an individual or team wins two or more tournaments in a given division in one year, they should move up to the higher division the following year. At the July 10 paddle tennis meeting, the consensus of the board members, tournament directors and everyone else was

that this rule should still be followed with certain exceptions: "Open" players have no where to move up to and players over the age of 55 should not have to move up.

Why Would Anyone Not Want to Move Up?

Often, players are not as successful in their first year in a higher division. We would all agree, it isn't much fun to play two and the you're out. Players who spend a full year in the higher division, may, if they desire, return to the lower division if they have not placed in any of the events of the higher division.

Of course, anyone who wants to move up to a higher division may do so whenever they feel ready. They do not have to win an event to move up. You may even want to play in a higher division before you are truly ready but it might not be very pleasant. I usually recommend to beginners that they enter their first tournament in the lowest division (unless Stephen Eberg decides to play paddle tennis next year--Ed.) That way they get a feel for the level of play in their chosen division and they can always move up in the next event!

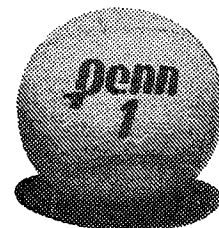
